- 1. On 29 January 2019, Cabinet agreed to proposals on the reform of vocational education [CAB-19-MIN-0009 refers]. These proposals are outlined in a draft consultation document, which has been provided to you and your colleagues for review.
- 2. We also provided three technical discussion documents for your review on Monday (Metis 1176548 refers). These address the more technical elements of proposals considered by Cabinet that were not incorporated in the main consultation document.
- 3. The final set of materials to support engagement on the reform of vocational education are factsheets. These help different audiences understand what the changes would mean for them.
- 4. All consultation documents, including the technical discussion documents, need to be finalised later this week in order to have them printed and collated with other materials in time for the launch event on 13 February.
